## 1. Training

- 1) Select on the home screen.
- 2) Select a configuration from the list:

Configurations identified by ⊕ can only be edited with the club code.

The club Access code is "1234". It can be changed in the "Club access" menu.

3) Screen in TRAINING 20x1 min match mode:



Pressing a game setting brings up a new window in which you can:

- edit the length of the session.
- 2 sequence countdown (start timer by pressing start).
- 3 time-out countdown (stop sequence = start time-out by pressing stop ).
- 4 the buzzer can be activated at the end of each sequence or time-out.
- 5 auto mode: if activated (yellow button) the sequence will be triggered after each time-out.
- 6 edit the configuration settings (see next page for the list of settings).
- display the scrolling message.
- 8 begin next sequence.
- 9 start a new session (go back to step 2 above).
